This application is for the Leadership Academy offered by Project Archaeology. Participants will spend three days at Montana State University learning about cultural resources on public lands and the importance of protecting these lands for their scientific and heritage values. The Academy will focus on the curriculum *Project Archaeology: Investigating Shelter*, an inquiry-based social studies and science curriculum, which guides students through a complete archaeological investigation of shelter. Teachers who attend the Academy will learn to use the curriculum and will learn about archaeological inquiry. Upon completion of the three-day Academy, teachers will return to their home states and will be expected to teach the curriculum to their peers through workshops, institutes, or job-embedded mentoring.

Lodging and food will be provided. Two university credits are available for interested participants. Attendees will need to purchase a copy of *Project Archaeology: Investigating Shelter* and *Intrigue of the Past* (\$37). Applications are due by April 1, 2012.
